In this project you will learn...

- How to work together and understand each other by getting to know your teachers and peers.
- Some ways in which you can hold successful discussions.
- How to document a journal.
- How to review your arts experiences.
- Arts skills in all the main areas of Art, Music, Media, Drama and Dance.
- An understanding of the artistic techniques that are used in a variety of arts areas to explore and express your identity.
- Experience a key text through reading 'This Morning I Met a Whale' and reflecting on the messages of the story.
- How to develop an understanding of your identity and of the identity of others whilst creating a performance / arts demonstration.
- How to create and develop your own work, whilst working in either small groups, or on your own.
- To develop one particular art skill.
- Learn how to respond to art work and develop your reflective skills following feedback from your teachers.
- Present your work in a final exhibition.
- Learn how to reflect upon, and review your work.


