- Think about what Geography is and write down everything you already know about it


How will I be assessed?

In this project you will learn...

- How to define Geography and describe the different types of Geography –(Social) Human, Physical, Environmental.
- How to give examples of the different types of Geography.
- How to ask geographical questions
- What makes a good question.
- How to work independently to identify geographical questions based on a variety of geographic images displayed on the board.
- Work with others to investigate the home place of Conwy.
- Learn how to consider Social (human), Environmental and Physical factors in their research.
- How to use direction and symbols on OS maps and understand why they are important
- How to use compass points
- To be able to use and understand how four and six figure grid references can be used to navigate on an OS map
- To understand the 3 types of height methods used layer colouring, contours and spot heights
- To learn how to use distance and scale to navigate a route on a
- To link the skills from previous lessons to plan a route.
