#### **Restart a Heart Day**


The whole school takes part in CPR training.

As well as having lessons in Mandarin, they are also treated to cultural activities such as traditional wood-carving, painting and martial arts.

The Confucius Centre at the University provides opportunities for the students to practise their Mandarin outside the classroom, with visits to a local tea-picking and tasting business, local temples and a beautiful island off the coast of Xiamen called Gulang Yu.

Before leaving the University to spend a few days being tourists in Shanghai, the students sit their final exams - they all pass!

#### **Sixth Form Ball Celebrations**


