

Understanding your Examination Results Statement

On results day you will receive a 'Statement of Results'. THIS IS NOT YOUR FINAL CERTIFICATE. The statement lists ALL the exam you have taken and any components within the qualification.

A capital letter indicates an OVERALL grade, whereas a lowercase letter indicates a COMPONENT within the qualification. The points are the value given to the OVERALL grade for data analysis. 'X' – this means no results; 'Q' result pending.

EXAM CERTIFICATES

The exam boards send the certificates to school November/December after the summer season. You can collect these from school from January 2024.

Students can collect their certificates in person or nominate somebody to collect on their behalf. All certificates will need to be signed for.

Under regulation, we are authorised to keep certificates for a minimum of 12 months from the date of issue. After 12 month, any unclaimed certificates can be destroyed in a confidential manner.

Certificates are valuable documents as they are the official record of exam results and should be looked after very carefully. The school cannot provide replacements if they are lost; you must request replacements from the exam boards directly, for which they charge a fee.
