We all know how important it is that we work together to ensure your child gets the most from their time with us. The aim of this letter is to highlight some areas where we would like your support in order to help us in maintaining a thriving learning environment at Ysgol Aberconwy. We also want to share details of sessions we will be providing to further support parents and help strengthen those all-important home/school partnerships.

Mobile Phones and Yondr

The creation of a phone free space has proved to be a great success. Every student was provided with a Yondr pouch free of charge in September and is expected to have it with them at all times. They may decide to leave their phones at home but they should bring their pouch to school regardless as we check them regularly. It would be helpful if you could let us know if your child regularly leaves their phone at home by emailing your child's [Guidance Mentor](#).

Equipment

Occasionally, a few students arrive to school without basic equipment which disrupts their learning and can impact on a whole class whilst replacement equipment is sought. Therefore, we would like to remind all parents of the home-school agreement signed upon joining the school and ask that you please check regularly that students have pens, pencil, ruler and a calculator in their bags as well as any other equipment they might need for certain lessons.

Attendance

You may be aware that school attendance is a national focus and at Ysgol Aberconwy we expect attendance of 95% or higher for every child. Poor attendance can seriously impact on the education of a child and may have legal consequences. For context, 90% attendance is the equivalent of a day's absence per fortnight and 80% is the equivalent of a day off school per week. Maintaining a high level of school attendance is a legal requirement for all parents and improves a child's life chances immeasurably. It is also a requirement to inform us by 9.30am if a child is unable to attend school and to provide a reason. This can be done by calling our school reception or via the [School Gateway](#) app.
