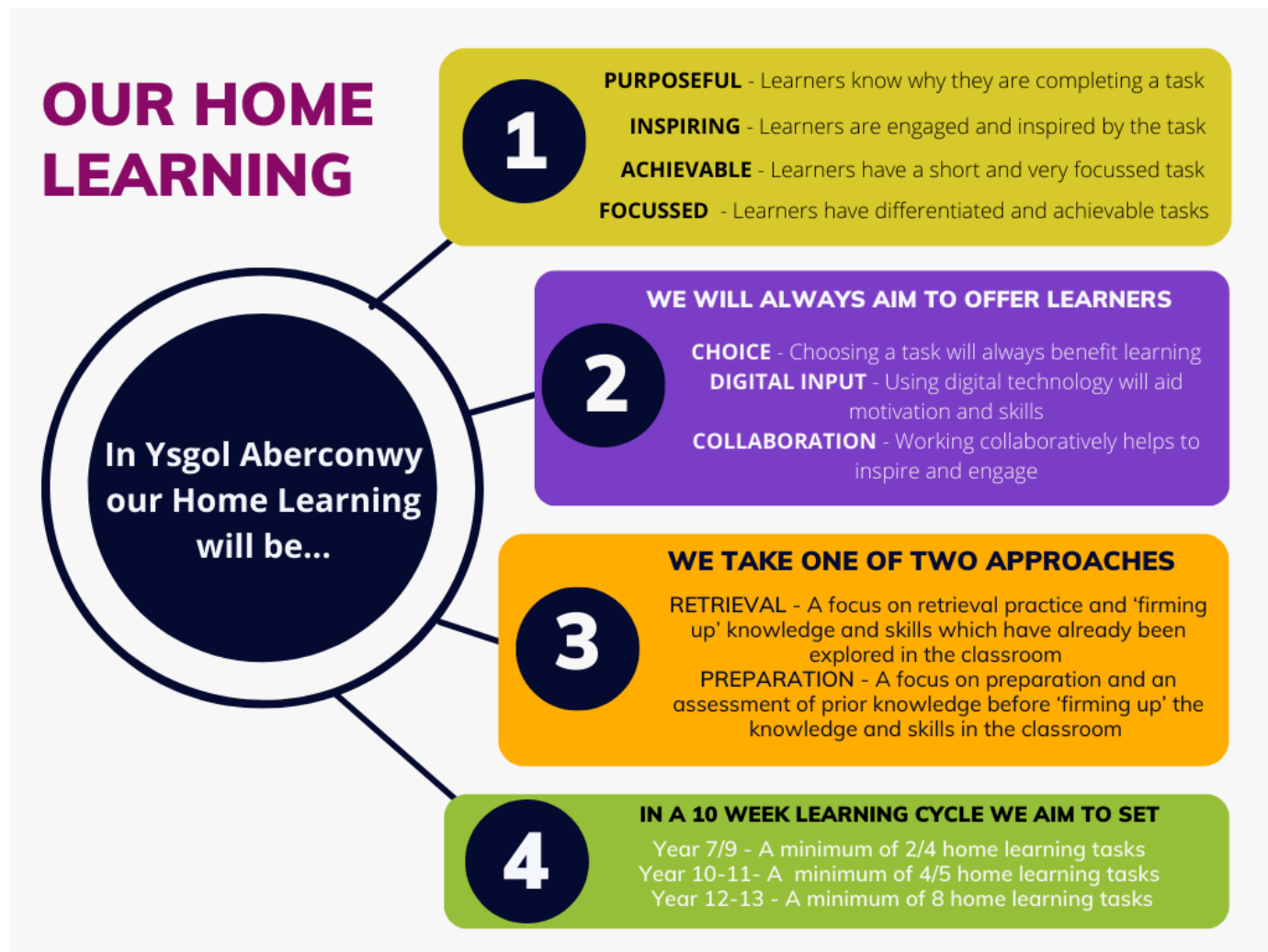
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POLICY STATEMENT – HOME LEARNING

1. Rationale

Home Learning is an important part of pupils' experience of school. It sows the seeds of independent study which, it is hoped, will grow through to adult life. It supports school work by providing opportunities for research, learning and reinforcement of classwork.

The school has a clear Home Learning policy set out in the graphic below



Home Learning will always strive to be;

1. **Purposeful**
2. **Inspiring**
3. **Achievable**
4. **Focussed**

It should always be designed around a preparatory task or a retrieval task. The expected levels of home learning are set out in the green box above. This has flexibility built into it to

account for the number of lessons/sessions taught over a 10-week learning cycle and is also modified as appropriate for the level of the learner – KS3, GCSE or Post-16

All pupils should undertake Home Learning. The school should seek the support of parents in ensuring that pupils complete work, and should develop in pupils a sense of personal responsibility for its completion to a high standard.

The school asks that all Home Learning is set via Microsoft Teams and in order to improve both home/school communication and parental support in our home learning a weekly email is sent to all parents with the Home Learning tasks for each student that have been set.

3. **Guidelines**

To implement this policy the school will:

1. Seek parental support in ensuring that Home Learning is completed
2. Ensure that all Home Learning tasks are set through the Teams platform
3. Set all Home Learning tasks within the guidelines of the Home Learning graphic above.
